Safeguarding & Protecting Children

Every child deserves to enjoy their sport. This workshop will raise your awareness of the tell-tale sign of abuse and poor practice, and give you the tools you need to deal with any issues sensitively, appropriately and effectively should the need ever arise in your coaching career.

Emergency First Response (Primary Care)

Emergency First Response Primary Care (CPR) teaches participants how to respond to life-threatening emergencies. The course focuses on primary care through a combination of knowledge development, skill development and realistic scenario practice to make sure participants have the confidence in their ability to provide care when emergency situations arise. (AED) Defibrillator training is also included.
